# BUILDING CAMPAIGN UPDATE

## BUILDING DESIGN PROGRESS UPDATE

We have recently completed several important milestones in our journey to build the new St. Anne Catholic Church.

## BUILDING SITE DRAINAGE BUFFER REQUIREMENTS

RLC Consultants have completed their work to investigate and determine the need for buffers surrounding drainage areas found on the property. We are waiting for a letter from our local authorities. We will need to file a land disturbance permit once the construction project gets underway.

## PROPERTY SITE SURVEY

Thomas & Hutton Engineering has previously completed this work. A site plan was produced in June for use by architects and engineers during the construction phase of the project.

## CIVIL ENGINEERING

Terracon has completed their work and submitted their report to Thomas & Hutton. Thomas & Hutton used this information to complete the civil design work necessary for the project.

## LANDSCAPE DESIGN

Grimball Cotterill is the landscape architectural firm assigned this responsibility. They are currently working to complete this effort by the end of July.

**Religious Education 2011-12 - Registration Information**  
*Please note, to be eligible to receive any of the following sacraments - 1st Reconciliation, 1st Eucharist, or Confirmation, a student is expected to meet the following minimum requirements:*

*Regularly attended religious education for the year immediately prior to the current school year; either at St. Anne's, or to provide a transfer/letter of participation from their previous parish for that prior year.*

*During that prior year of religious education the student should have attended/ completed 75% or more of the scheduled religious education classes, either at St. Anne's or their previous parish. Students are expected to also continue regularly attending classes during the final sacramental preparation year.*

*Inconsistent attendance may result in a student being deferred to a later sacrament date.*

*You may contact the Director of Religious Education at the parish office at 912-756-3343 or via email at [cyndy@stannerh.org](mailto:cyndy@stannerh.org) if you have any questions about registration or class placement. Thank you.*

**"Registration forms may be returned to the parish office during business hours. Families may also register in person after all Masses the weekend of July 30-31. A second weekend registration will take place after all Masses on August 6-7 at the parish stewardship fair that weekend."**

*2011-12 Religious Education Registration is on-going at this time. Registration forms are available in the parish office during posted business hours. Forms are also located on the bookshelf in the Holy Family Hall foyer after all Sunday Masses.*

*Fees are \$30 for the first child in a family and \$15 for any additional students in the same family. On July 1<sup>st</sup> fees will go up to \$35 & \$20 respectively. Please be sure to take a gold colored information sheet with our start dates/times and other information on it.*

*All families must be registered in the parish to participate in religious education classes. You may complete that form at the time you register.*
